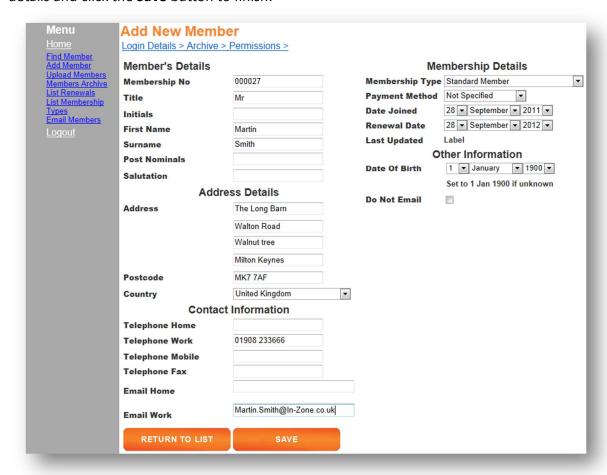

2 Managing Your Members

2.1 Add New Members - Individually

From the main menu click **Member Admin**, **Add Member** and enter your new member details and click the **Save** button to finish.



If new membership types are required click the List Membership Types link from the main Member Admin main menu. Once added the Membership Type drop down box will include your new membership type.

2.2 Add New Members - Batch Upload

Upload a CSV file containing your member details. CSV files may be exported from many software applications or created with tools such as Microsoft Excel.

If the data uploaded contains members with the same membership number the new details will overwrite the existing data. All other member details will create a new member on the database.

The file must contain the following data fields, in the correct order and format. Fields marked * cannot be left blank. If you would like to download a sample file please login to your account click Member Admin, Find Member and click the Download button.

The table below lists out what the various fields within the upload file mean.

To upload the file, click on the Browse button to locate the CSV file then click on the Upload button.

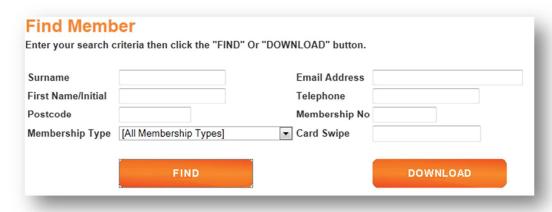

2.3 Managing Members - Find

Click Member Admin and **Find Member** from the menu.



The system supports fuzzy searching so entering Jo will return all Johns and Johnsons etc

Card Swipe coupled with a Magnetic Card Reader enables you to swipe your membership card and the system will automatically retrieve and display the member record. (Requires the Card-Zone module)

From the Find member screen click the View or Amend button:



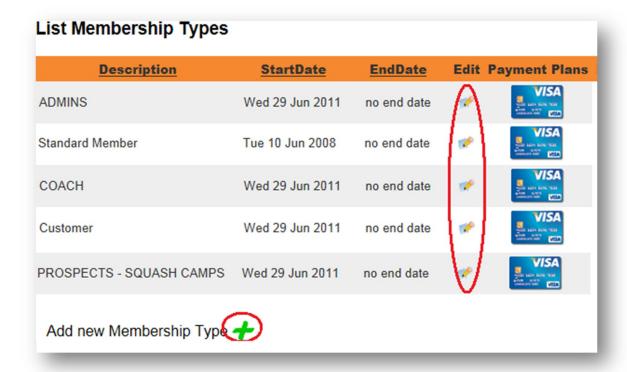
At the Edit Member details screen make your changes and click the Save button.

2.5 Managing Member - Membership Types

To display a list of all the current membership types click the **List Membership Types** link in the LHS menu.



To amend an existing membership type, click the Edit icon to display the **Edit Membership Types** screen.



Amend the Description, Start & End Dates (Leave blank for no end date) and click the **update** button.

When finished click the **Return to List** button

To add a new membership type click the **Add new Membership Type** icon.

2.6 Managing Members - Permissions

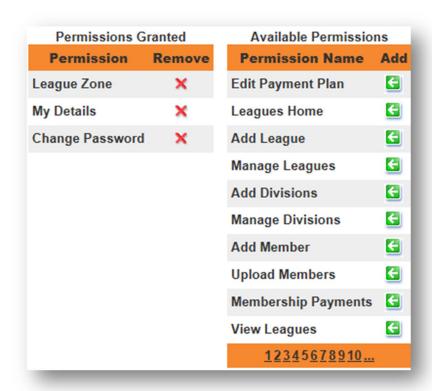
Permissions allow you to grant members access to additional functionality.

Find and edit the member record and click the permissions link.

Grant or remove permissions by clicking on \times or \hookrightarrow buttons. Below is an example of a standard member's set of permissions.

<u>Note:</u> If you want to grant another member permission to manage the leagues you need to grant the following permissions:

League Zone, Leagues Home, Add League, Manage Leagues, Add Divisions, Manage Divisions and View Leagues.

3 Managing your Leagues

3.1 Initial setup - Points allocation table

Scoring systems vary from club to club so you may need to amend the points allocated per game.

The point's allocation system is setup to allocate points based on the best of 5 games per match.

To amend the match points allocated do the following:

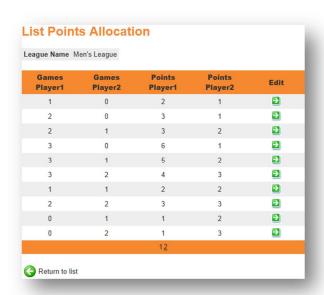
Click Manage Leagues from the menu and select the League

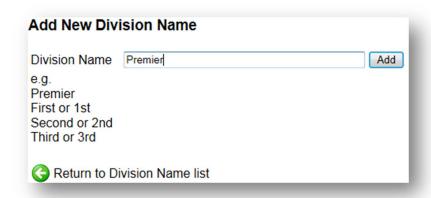


3.3 Initial Setup - Naming Your Divisions

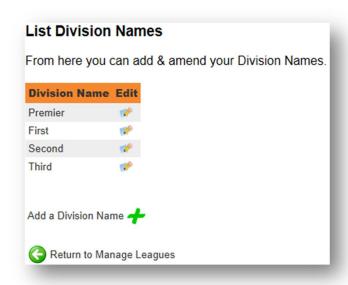
Before players can be added to their appropriate league division you need to name your divisions. So if for example you have 4 divisions each containing 5 players called 'Premier', 'First', 'Second' and 'Third' you will add division names for each one as named above.

From the LHS menu click the 'Add Divisions' link and complete the Add New Division Name dialogue. Repeat adding Division names until all division names have been added to the system.

(This process is only performed when adding new divisions to the system)

3.4 League Setup - Name your League

You can set up several different leagues, e.g. Men's, Women's, Juniors or even a virtual league formed from players in and around your area!

From the LHS menu click 'Add League' and give your league a Title e.g. The Ladies League or The Men's League.

Please note that this is the league title (e.g. Men's league) not the period.

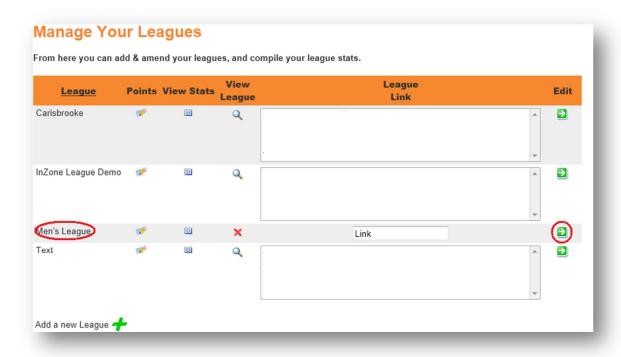
Click Add to save the name.



Your new league will be listed in the 'Manage Your League' screen along with your other leagues. To continue click the 'Return to Manage Leagues' icon.

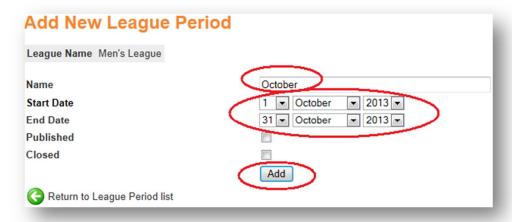


3.5 League Setup – Start and End dates

Start by adding your new league period.



Set the league period name e.g. October and set the start / end dates



Click Return to league period list to display the new period.

3.6 League Setup - Add Divisions to the League

From the League Periods screen click the division icon next to the league period to be updated.



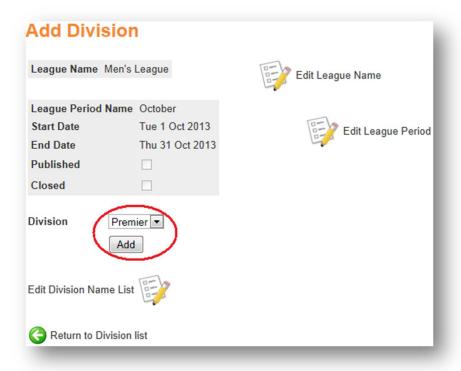
Click the Add new Division icon



Select the division to add from the Division drop down box and click add. Simply repeat for each division.

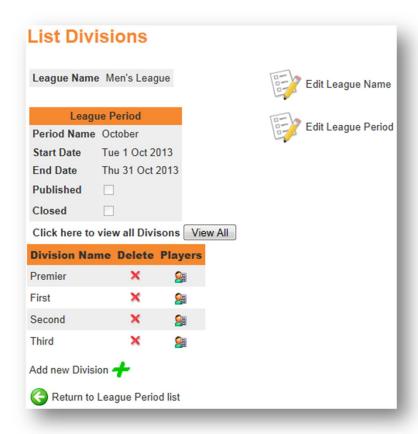

3.7 League Setup - Add players to the divisions

Having first added members and Division Names to the system (see Naming Your Divisions) you are ready to add players into each division.

You assign players to each division by selecting players from the Members already in the In-Zone database.

From the League Periods screen click the Divisions icon

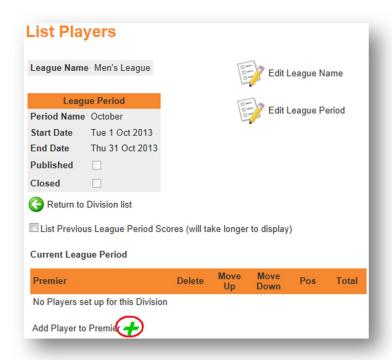




Then click by the name of each division to add players

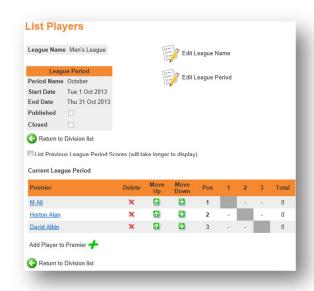
You then add players by clicking the 'Add player to Division' 🕇 icon.



Select players by ticking the add box next to their name.

Click 'Add Selected Players' to add the ticked players into the league.

3.8 League Setup - Publishing your league

When you have setup all the divisions and are ready to make it visible to players do the following:

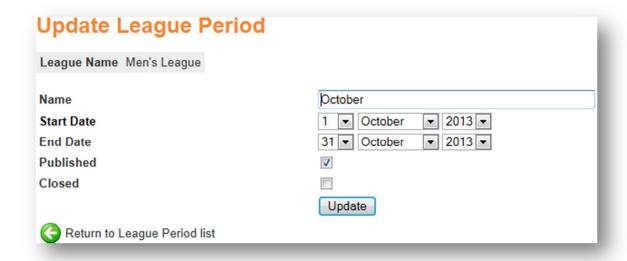
Click **Manage Leagues** from the menu then

Select your league by clicking edit next to your league name.

Click **Edit** to display the Update League Period screen and set the **Published** tick box to ticked.

Special note: check that the start date is either the current date (today) or earlier (i.e. **not** a future date). Failure to list at least one published division with a current start date will prevent any league details from being displayed.

Click the **Update** button to save your changes.



This division will now be visible to your players.

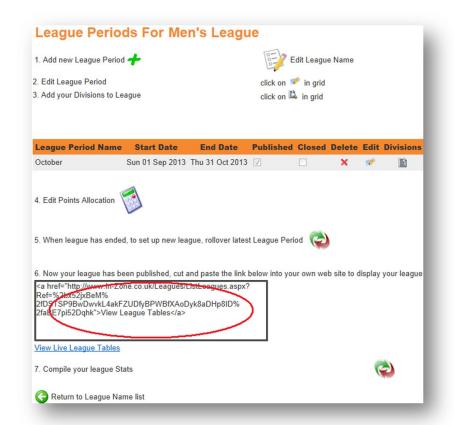

3.9 League Setup - Publishing to your website

Players access the leagues via a link to League Zone from your website. To link to your new leagues from your website you must copy and paste a link into your website as follows:

Click **Manage Leagues** from the LHS menu
Select your league by clicking edit next to your league name.



Cut and paste the link into your own website.

3.10 On-going - Month End Rollover

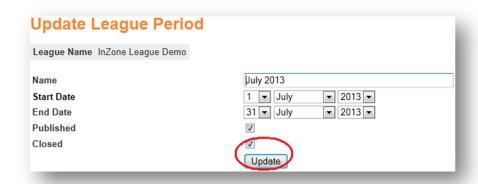
The League Rollover option is used to create the next League structure. It copies the current League (Divisions and Players) to a new version and allows you to enter a new League name along with new start and end dates.

During the rollover process you have the option to move players up and down within the leagues as follows:

- 1. Automatic 1 Move the top 2 players up 1 division and the bottom 2 players down 1 division.
- 2. Automatic 2 Move the top 1 player up 2 divisions and move the second from top player up 1 division. Move the bottom player down 2 divisions and move the second from bottom player down 1 division.
- 3. Manual, do not move any players up or down. This option simply creates a copy of the current league.

How to rollover your current league

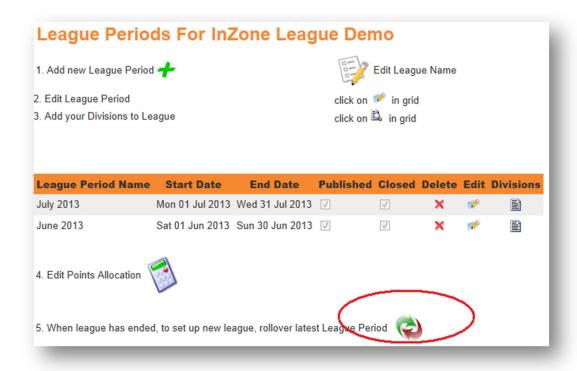
To prevent players from updating their scores first close the current league period by editing the current league period and tick the 'Closed' tick box and click the 'update' button.

At the Rollover League Period screen enter a new name for the league period e.g. August 2013, set the 'Start' and 'End' dates and select the Rollover method to be applied. When ready click the rollover button.

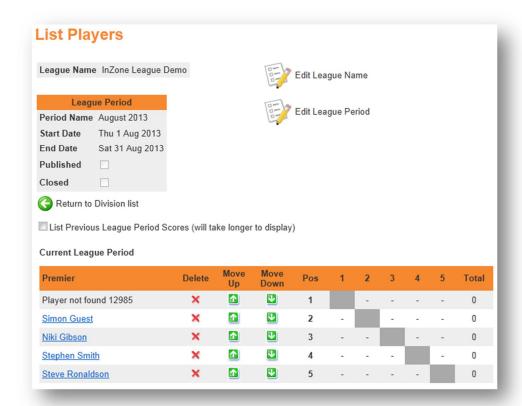
Rollover Method

- 1. Automatic 1 Move the top 2 players up 1 division and the bottom 2 players down 1 division.
- 2. Automatic 2 Move the top 1 player up 2 divisions and move the second from top player up 1 division. Move the bottom player down 2 divisions and move the second from bottom player down 1 division.
- 3. Manual, do not move any players up or down. This option simply creates a copy of the current league.

The system will automatically copy all the current players into the new league and display the new league for you to update.

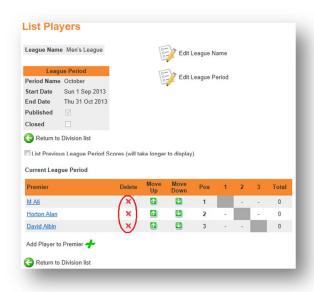


3.11 On-going - Removing a division from your league

To remove a division from your league you must remove the players from the division.



Select the division to remove players from.



and delete them from the division. When the players have been removed the division can be deleted from the List Divisions screen (shown above).

4 Scores

4.1 Scores - Entering Players Match Results

Players enter results by clicking the view leagues link you have added to your website (See <u>Publishing to you website</u>). Players simply click their name, enter their user name and password and enter their match results.

4.2 Scores - Entering Match Results Administrators

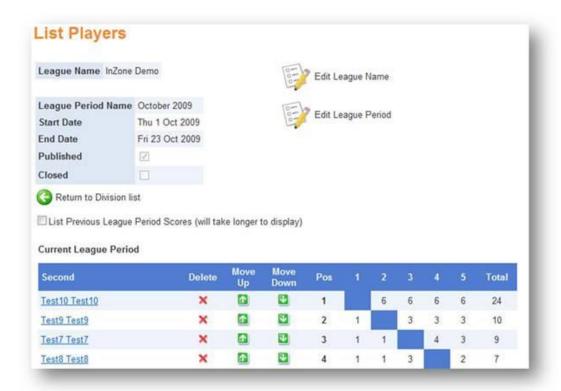
As the league administrator you can login and update any scores within the system.

4.3 Scores - Closing the league

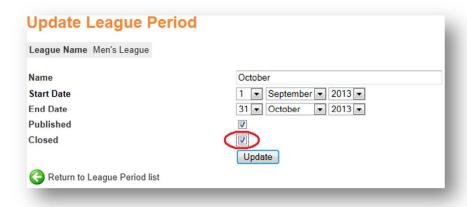
Players enter their own results until the administrator closes the league thereby allowing the players to enter their own results until the administrator decides otherwise.

Close the league as follows:

- Click Manage Leagues from the LHS menu
- Select your league by clicking edit to display the League Periods screen

4.4 Scores - Adjusting Players Match Results

The administrator can amend any result that was entered in error or has been disputed by the players as follows:

Click the **Divisions** icon icon for the period in question

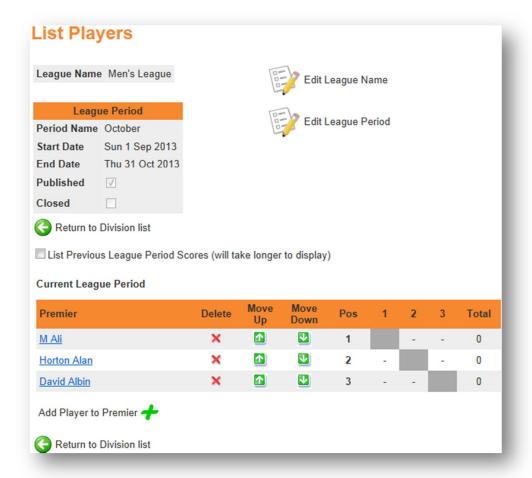




Click the **Players** icon so next to the league to be updated

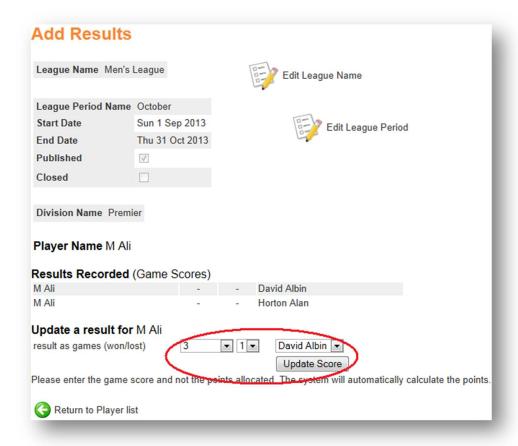
